



## Members Leaderboards Swan River Dressage 2024

Swan River Dressage Inc (SRDI) will be running Leaderboards across our competitions for our members in 2024. We will be holding a series of four dressage events in 2024 to compete for the Leaderboard, offering Competitor (official) tests from Preliminary to Grand Prix as well as Participant and Club (Unofficial) tests.

A High Point Leaderboard will run across each of these events for our members. Leaderboard prizes will be awarded to the winners of each category at our August event, which will be the Leaderboard Final event.

**\*\*\*Winners must attend to receive their award\*\*\***

### Leaderboard Rules:

1. To be eligible for points, horses or ponies must be ridden by a member of SRDI. Points will only accrue from the date the rider becomes a member of SRDI.
2. Horses or ponies must compete in at least 3 of the 4 events in the Series. If horses/ponies compete in all 4 events the 3 highest scores will be included in the leaderboard.
3. Points will be accrued as percentages by a horse or pony.
4. Winning competitors must participate in the appropriate presentations at our event on 31<sup>st</sup> August, which is the Leaderboard final, to be awarded prizes.
5. One percentage score - the highest percentage score for each SRDI member horse or pony in each of the categories below at each event - will be included in the Leaderboard scores.
6. The winner of each category will be the horse or pony with the highest aggregate from the Swan River Dressage Series within that category.
7. Prizes will be awarded in each of the categories below which has 3 or more horses/ponies entered in Preparatory, Preliminary, Novice and Elementary and 1 or more horses/ponies in Medium and above at each competition date, throughout the Series in 2024.

## **Categories – Competitor & Participant**

3. Participant Novice
4. Competitor Preliminary
5. Competitor Novice
6. Competitor Elementary
7. Competitor Medium
8. Competitor Advanced
9. FEI Small Tour - Prix St Georges & Intermediate I
10. FEI Medium Tour – Intermediate A & B
11. FEI Big Tour – Intermediate II & Grand Prix

## **Categories – Club (Unofficial)**

12. Club Prep
13. Club Preliminary
14. Club Novice
15. Club Elementary
16. Club Medium
17. Club Advanced

Where points are equal for horses or ponies within a category after event three, an additional point will be allocated where their highest percentage in event four was in the test in the category which has the highest level of difficulty (eg in Novice this would be 2C, in Small Tour this would be Intermediate I).

If there are equal point scorers after this has been calculated, an additional point will be allocated to horses or ponies with the highest total of collective marks from the test with the highest level of difficulty in event four in the category.

The Organising Committee's decision on each winner and on any further divisions within each category will be final.
